Dear Millennium Charter High School Community,

Our school is at another crossroads and we need your support! In December of this past year, we faced MCOE's request for us to close with an impassioned response from the school community led by our students and supported by parents and staff. It was your impassioned response as a community that kept Millennium from closure and allowed us the opportunity to remain open through the remainder of this academic year. Because MCOE has notified us of the intent to revoke, we now have a new challenge to stop the revocation and keep Millennium open.

Compass Charter Schools, a Charter Management Organization, approached the Millennium Board with an opportunity to merge and use their existing resources to help bring the school's fiscal and enrollment status into good standing. This merger requires a revision to the existing charter and MCOE Board approval. The Millennium Board is currently working on a charter amendment that will be presented to the MCOE Board of Directors before their May meeting for their review. Further, a powerpoint presentation is being prepared that highlights the main points of Compass' proposal.

On Wednesday, May 8th, the MCOE Board as a part of its regularly scheduled board meeting, will be holding a public hearing regarding its intent to move forward with revocation. The public hearing is scheduled to begin at 5:30 PM to allow the Millennium Charter High School community to participate. In order for Millennium to stand any chance at staying open, we need the full support of the Millennium community at the May 8th meeting. Please commit to attending and participating in this critical meeting.
